There will be a requirement to work some weekends and public holidays and intrastate travel may be required.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Contribute to the planning and delivery of the 2023 Alice Springs Masters Games.
2. Engage, coordinate, develop and deliver the sports program.
3. Manage at an operational level the Alice Springs Masters Event budget.
4. Have and hold broad oversight across all operational and sport functions including but limited to sport engagement, participant registration, volunteer management, safety and stakeholder engagement.
5. Facilitate and manage sports, event delivery, venues and service related contracts.
6. Where applicable delegate workflow to team members and volunteers.
7. Collaborate with and deliver an efficient and impactful volunteer program across the Alice Springs Masters Games
8. Implement and execute effective risk management across all activities and events.
9. Represent NTMEC as required at engagements and accurately document and provide reports as required.
10. Actively participate within our work place health and safety and risk management framework driving best practise.

11. Review, update and implement policies, procedures, standard operating procedures and business systems as required.
12. Engage with city, partner and event related stakeholders.
13. Actively participate and engage with and within your new team. You are encouraged to be yourself and contribute.
